

Dear Guests,

We warmly welcome you to attend NASC10 and come to visit Beijing.

Below you will find some important and useful information.

- **Registration Place:** Motel 168 (Zhong-Guan-Cun Branch) (莫泰 168(中关村店))
- **The Address of Motel 168 (Zhong-Guan-Cun Branch) :** No. 106, The East Zhong-Guan-Cun Road, Hai-Dian District (海淀区中关村东路 106 号); **Tel.:** +86-10-82121666
- **Registration Time:** 15:00–17:30PM, October 22, 2010
- **Reminding Note:** Please manage your dinner of October 22 if you arrive at the hotel after 18:00PM
- **The Address of the Jade Palace Hotel (翠宫饭店):** No. 76, Zhi-Chun Road, Hai-Dian District (海淀区知春路 76 号); **Tel.:** +86-10-62628888
- **Beijing Airport to Motel 168 and the Jade Palace Hotel:**

**Way 1:** Take a taxi directly to the hotels. It costs about RMB 100 Yuan. You can ask the driver to go from the airport highway to the forth ring road by making a right turn along the west direction. When you arrive the Bo-Fu-si Bridge (保福寺桥) or the Third Bridge of Zhong-Guan-Cun (中关村 3 桥), make a left turn and go on the East Road of Zhong-Guan-Cun (中关村东路), after two red crosses you will see the Jade Palace Hotel on your right and Motel 168 (Zhong-Guan-Cun Branch) on your left.

**Way 2:** Take the Zhong-Guan-Cun (中关村) line of the airport bus to the Third Bridge of Zhong-Guan-Cun (中关村 3 桥) or the Bo-Fu-Si Bridge (保福寺桥), which is the terminal station of this line. The cost is RMB 16 Yuan per person. Then you can take a taxi to the hotels, which costs about RMB 10 Yuan. Or you can just walk to the hotels within about 20 minutes. From Bo-Fu-Si Bridge you can walk along the south direction on the East Road of Zhong-Guan-Cun; the hotels are just after the second red cross.

**Important Notes:** The local organizing committee WILL NOT arrange pick up from and to Beijing airport and train stations. So, please manage your transportation to the hotels by yourself. Just for your safety, PLEASE ASK A REGULAR RECEIPTS WHEN YOU TAKE A TAXI OR THE AIRPORT BUS in case there could be some trouble!
